But with Spencer Cox, John Uglum and Charles Belluardo absent for the final round of the challenge, there was the opportunity for others to earn points and make up ground in the quest for the inaugural JX2/Pirelli Triple Crown Championship podium, special Triple Crown series trophy and custom JX2 Pirelli Champion's jacket and accolades that come with being the Champion.

Keeping it in the family, Geoff Isringhausen Jr. also impressed, earning enough points to finish just off the podium, behind the absent Spencer Cox who finished third in the Triple Crown Championship series.
